### Profile

Wildman, Harrold, Allen & Dixon is a Chicago-based law firm with 192 attorneys (as of 9/30/08), practicing out of American offices and one office in London. It is the 222nd largest firm in the United States according to the *National Law Journal's* 2008 NLJ 250 rankings. In terms of revenue, the firm ranked in 200th place on *The American Lawyer's* 2007 Am Law 200 rankings with \$94,000,000 in gross revenue in 2006. The firm's practice is organized into six areas: corporate, government affairs, intellectual property, labor and employment, litigation, and real estate. Areas of expertise include patent law, labor compliance, environmental law, and corporate governance.
